

Lesson 14: Possessives Part 2

Possessives 2

The more common way to form the possessive in spoken Persian is to add the following endings to the word. Here is the example word $\Rightarrow / kh\hat{a}har$ (sister) with the respective endings.

خواهرمان	ما	خواهرم	من
khâharemun	mâ	khâharam	man
خواهرتان	شما	خواهرت	تو
khâharetun	shomâ	khâharet	to
خواهرشان	آنها	خواهرش	او
khâhareshun	ânhâ	khâharesh	u (00)

The other way to form the possessive that we learned in Lesson 11 is more commonly used for emphasis.
